Enrollment for Summer School classes will be open to Soto Academy students first. Registration for Soto Academy students will **begin on February 6.** On **March 1<sup>st</sup>** registration will be **open to the public.** **Early registration** rates end on March 23. **Regular registration** rates begin on March 24. **Most classes will be taught by Soto Academy Staff.**

Soto Academy’s Summer School Program has two sessions. **Option 1**

**and Option 2** are for students entering grade K through grade 5 in the fall.

Students may attend either Session I or both Sessions I & II. **Lunch and Study Hall** are included **only if attending both sessions.** (Option 2) Lunch is part of the program and no refund or reduction in cost will be given if you send home lunch.

## **Enrollment and Admissions**

Session I only: Entering grade K through grade 5 in the fall.

Session I & II: Entering grade K through grade 5 in the fall

### **Enrollment**

To enroll in Session I or Session I & II, you must complete a registration form for the program. Applications (with accompanying deposits) are accepted by mail or in person on a first-come, first-serve basis until classes are filled.

Early enrollment is encouraged. Pre-registration for Soto Academy students **ends on February 28<sup>th</sup>**. You will receive your enrollment confirmation via e-mail within a week of submitting your applications. If you have not received your confirmation after a week, please call the office (533-0452). Enrollment will be open to the public on March 1.

## Fees and Payment Policy

For early registration, a deposit of \$200.00 must accompany each application. There is **no refund of your deposit after March 23.** **Balance of Summer School tuition is due on or before March 23.** Your child will not be considered enrolled and guaranteed a spot unless payment is made **by this date.** **NO TUITION REFUND after March 31.** (Please understand that the school needs time to plan and obligate spending.)

Regular registration opens March 24. Full tuition payment must accompany each application if classes are still available for Sessions I, Session II, or both. Your child will not be considered enrolled and guaranteed a spot unless payment is made. **NO TUITION REFUND after March 31.**

**Description of Classes**

**Session I** classes provide both review and enrichment work in reading, writing, and math. Students are placed in their appropriate grade level, where the teachers evaluate strengths and adjusts according to needs. These classes should provide a smoother transition into their new grade level and build confidence. Session I has some homework which can easily be completed during study hall.

**Supplies to be brought on first day of program: Session I**

K	Box of 16 crayons, scissors, glue stick, two #2 pencils, large eraser, 1 portfolio, change of clothes in ziploc bag, and final report card.
1 <sup>st</sup>	1 glue stick, 1 wide-ruled composition book, 1 portfolio, two #2 pencils, crayons, scissors, and final report card.
2 <sup>nd</sup> , 3 <sup>rd</sup> 4 <sup>th</sup> & 5 <sup>th</sup>	1 wide-ruled composition book, 1 portfolio, two #2 pencils, crayons, scissors, ruler and final report card.

❖ **Report cards will be given at the end of the six week program.**

**Session II** Afternoon classes, like last year, will include, art, music, P.E., cooking, computer and robotics. Other possible classes are being considered and discussed. As usual, we want worthwhile, fun classes with good teachers. Lunch will be served in our cafeteria, after which students will be brought to a Study Hall class. (Lunch and Study Hall are included only if attending Session I and II.) A schedule of the classes will be provided at a later date. Session II has no homework.
